REUNION

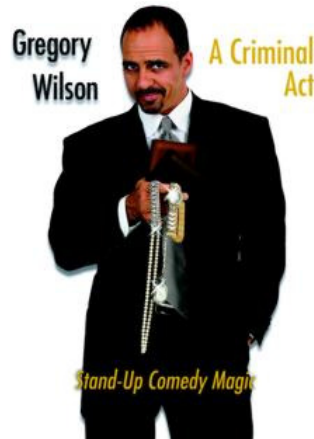

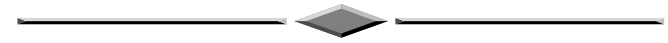

Many thanks to those who support our raffles. Both the donors of raffle prizes and the purchasers of the tickets.

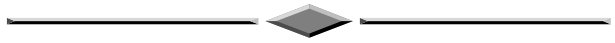
Many thanks to **Bill Pearce** for running a great raffle with lots of interesting magic items that are always well received.



THANKS TO ALL MEMBERS THAT WEAR THEIR BADGES






Magic Consignment Table

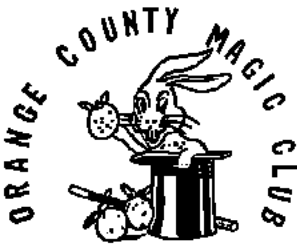
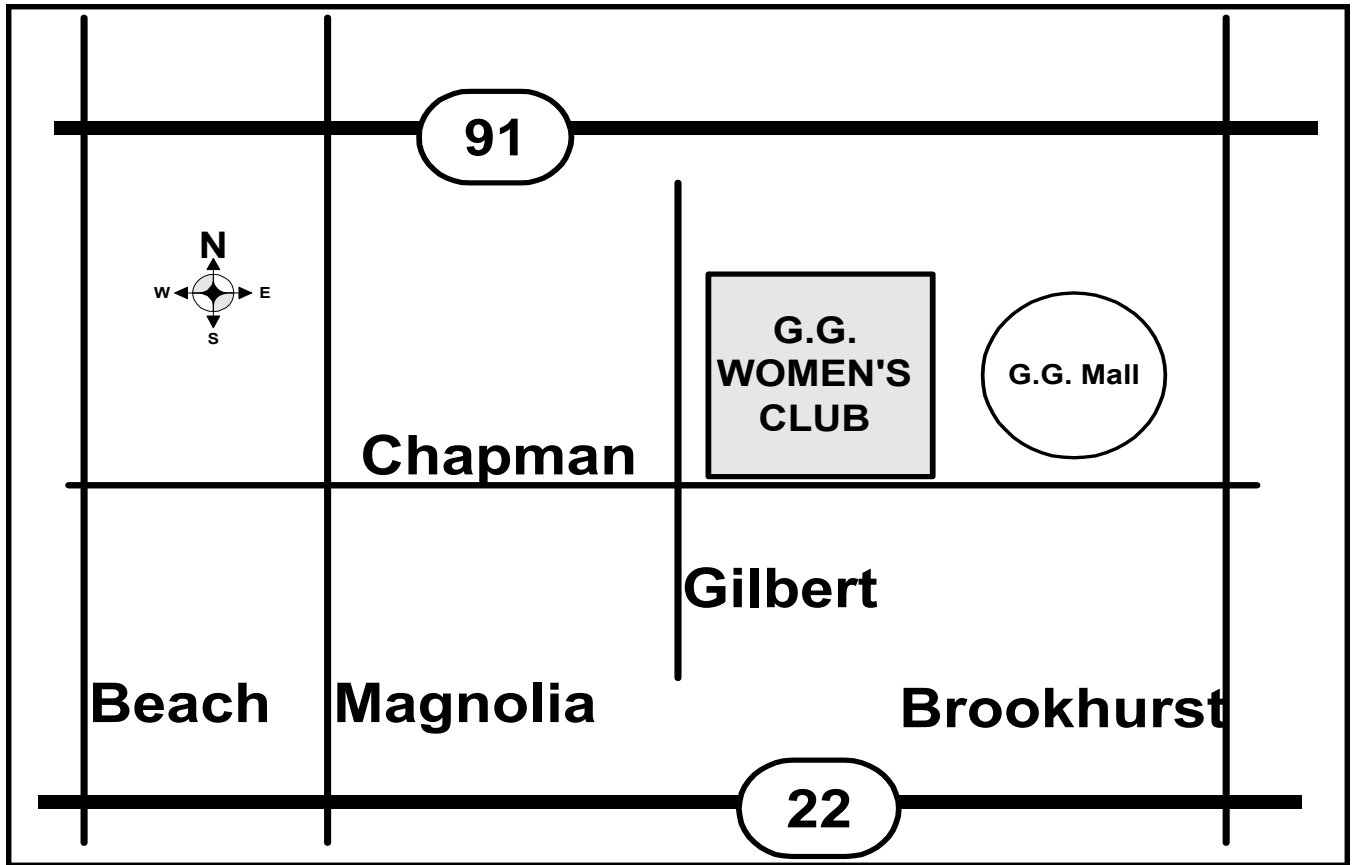
PROFESSIONAL MAGIC WORKSHOP (FOR ADULTS, AGES 16 AND ABOVE)
